Lower School Tests

Please remember that revision is done in class and clearly structured revision preps will be set in the run up to the tests.

There is no need for you to do anything extra with your child in Yr3 and Yr4, other than the support suggested below and the directions given by form tutors.

In Yr5 there is a revision booklet for each pupil to complete at home. Some tasks will be set as specific prep before the exams. This booklet will not be marked by the teachers, it is simply to guide and focus pupils in their revision.

In all year groups, if you can help your children with the revision preps, test them and keep encouraging their reading they should be fine.

The material on the website about Lower School tests is there for your information. There is certainly no need for you to go through it with your child. Our aim is to keep pupils calm in their approach to the tests; we prepare them in school, ensuring they know everything they need to.
