



Year 7 French Revision Summer 2012

The Exam Will Consist of 4 papers in each of the four skills:

Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing, each skill earning a maximum of 25%

French Speaking examinations will take place during the week beginning Monday 07th May and will be conducted by the pupil's usual French Teacher.

The Speaking Examination for Sets 1, 2 and 3 consists of one Role-play (10%) and a Prepared Topic on Moi et ma famille (15%).

The Speaking Examination for Set 4 (Beginners) consists of a Prepared Topic on Moi et ma famille and general questions

The French Listening examination will also take place during the week beginning 07th May.

French Reading and Writing examinations will take place during exam week, beginning Monday 14th May.
