### *“Henry should behead Cromwell!”*

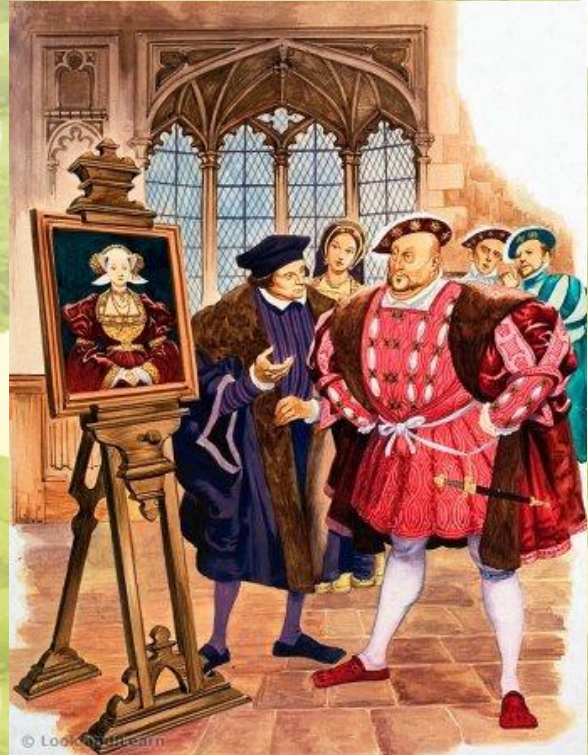
